

# The 2017 SA Pony Rider & Junior Dressage Derby

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Entry Fee: **R300.00** per class for classes 90a, 90b,91a,91b,92a,92b,93,94,95

**R250.00** per class for classes 96,97,98,99,100,101,102,103

(Incl. R64.98 Ground levy, R17.10 DSA Levy, R5.13 EDS levy,R15 JOC levy, R30 Security/ Medical Levy & R50.00 Officials Levy Incl. VAT.)

**Non KPC Members will pay an extra R100.00 arena fee.**

## Definition of Age Classifications as per DSA Rule 31.4.0

Children: Category of Athletes who may take part in Children Competitions until the end of the year they reach the age of fourteen (14)

Junior: Category of Athletes who may take part in Competitions for Juniors from the year they reach the age of fourteen (14) until the end of the year they reach the age of eighteen (18).

Young Rider: Category of Athletes who may take part in Competitions for Young Riders from the beginning of the year they reach the age of sixteen (16) until the end of the year they reach the age of twenty one (21)

Pony Rider: Category of Athletes who may take part in Competitions for Pony Riders until the end of the year they reach the age of sixteen (16) riding Ponies as specified in DSA rule 31.5.2.

**R 300.00 Starting Fee** (inclusive of DSA Levy) per qualifying horse/pony for the Pony Rider, Children and Junior Dressage Derby, payable after completion of qualifying tests.

**TESTS:** Tests to be ridden are the current tests published on the DSA website.(DSA tests available from DSA website and KPC office)

**NOTE:** There will be no 5% penalty for a horse or pony competing in a lower than its registered grade. However no grading points will be awarded.

1. Pony Rider's Dressage Derby (Class 92a) is open to and compulsory for the three top qualified pony and rider combinations based on points gained in Classes 90a & 91a.
2. Children's Dressage Derby (Class 92b) is open to and compulsory for the three top qualified pony/horse and rider combinations based on points gained in Classes 90b & 91b.
3. Junior Dressage Derby (Class 95) is open to and compulsory for the three top qualified horse and rider combinations based on points gained in Classes 93 & 94. NB: Ponies measuring 1.48 and under are not eligible to compete in the Junior Dressage Derby (class 95).
4. Points will be awarded as follows:

**(Ties will be awarded full points)**

5. In the event of equality of points for any of the three qualifying places, the marks gained in the two qualifying classes by tying competitors will be the deciding factor. If the equality persists, the collective marks in the higher tests will be the deciding factor. If the equality continues to persist, the judges' decision will be final.
6. The competitor qualifying in fourth place will be required to stand by in case of a scratching and to ride a *test ride* for the judges at the beginning of the competition.
7. Each rider rides his own pony/horse first and thereafter will ride in the following order starting with the lowest qualification combination ;  
Rider 1-2-3-2-3-1-3-1-2  
Horse 1-2-3-1-2-3-1-2-3
8. Each rider is given THREE minutes to ride the strange horse before starting the test.  
In the event of equality of marks for the winning rider, the total of the individual marks given by each judge in all three tests for the Rider's "Position & Seat & Correct use of aids" shall be the deciding factor. The same procedure shall apply should there be a tie for the winning horse, except the marks given for "Paces" will be the deciding factor.
9. Should a rider qualify more than one horse/pony for the Derby, the rider shall have the option to nominate which one horse/pony he chooses to ride when paying the Starters Fee.
