VARIATION OF PROGRAMME	The advertised programme and classes will be adhered to as far as possible. However, in the light of unforeseen circumstances the Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide or postpone any class providing such alteration is within the frame work of Rules. No refunds after closing date of entries. An athlete may compete in any level on any horse <i>Hors Concours</i>. Adult “Open” Riders can compete on horses at a level higher than the horses present grade – in accordance with DSA Rules 2017 (effective 1 January 2018).
RIDING TIMES	Times will be posted on KPC website and DSA website. The onus is on the competitor to check the final starting order before the start of the class at the arena that the classes are to be held.
SHOW NUMBERS	Will be allocated and published and this number must be attached to the LEFT-HAND SIDE of the halter/head collar and/or to the numnah/bridle.
CATERING	Public Catering will be available at Kyalami Park Club.
SADDLERY AND DRESS	The event will be run under current DSA rules and General Regulations unless otherwise stated.
PASSPORT	All horses entered in this show must have fully completed SAEF or FEI passports. Passports must accompany the horse. Competitors whose passports are not up to date or incomplete (including vaccinations) will be fined as per DSA / SAEF regulations.

AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS AND EQUINE FLU	All horses must be vaccinated with AHS vaccine and with Equine Influenza and in accordance with the regulations laid out in the equestrian rules. Horses that do not comply may be refused permission to compete and can be asked to leave the show grounds.
CONDUCT	Any owner or rider who attempts to interfere with or influence judges, officials or stewards, or who at any time on the show grounds uses any contemptuous or abusive language to any of the judges, officials or stewards will forfeit his/her rights to any prizes to which they might otherwise be entitled and will receive a yellow card which will require them to remove themselves and their horse from the grounds pending a disciplinary enquiry.
PRIZES MONEY AND PRIZE GIVING OBLIGATIONS	AMATEUR SERIES: Rosettes only, plus Sponsorship for the Final Leg of the Series. NON-PROFESSIONAL SERIES: Rosettes only, Prize Money (accumulated over the series) for the Final Leg. (Less levies & VAT). GRADED CLASSES: A minimum of 40% of entry fees (less levies & VAT) distributed overall at the discretion of the Organising Committee, subject to DSA General Regulations 2017.

This series is aimed at the riders that would like to try their hand at competitive Dressage. It is for the beginner and recreational rider. You have the opportunity to compete at a pristine venue whilst having fun! Riders and horses need to be dressed and turned out correctly. Rosettes will be handed out at all the legs and Prize Money, Rosettes and title will be for the Winner at the Final Leg. Entry Fees are R200.00 per class (excluding the non-membership fee). If you are not a member of KPC, an additional temp membership fee of R150 will apply. There will be 5 legs to this series with a Final in October. (A minimum of 3 need to be completed to qualify for the Final Leg). Dates are as follows:

2. NON-PROFESSIONAL SERIES

This series is aimed at the riders that have competed in Dressage before but do not receive monetary compensation for riding, schooling, instructing (with or without qualifications) but would like to compete at a top class venue and receive grading points and would like to further their Dressage careers. The riders can compete in the graded section or the recreational section. This series is to comprise of 5 legs with a Final in October.

The riders will receive rosettes for all the Legs, except for the Final Leg – where the accumulated monies (from the previous legs) will be to the Final winners (less all the levies).
