Refunds	No Refunds will be given after closing date of entries. Should the show be cancelled due to inclement weather or entries cancelled before closing date, a 20% admin fee will be deducted from all refunded entry fees.

Inter-District & Gauteng Championship / Consolation Format	The 2019 Inter-District and Gauteng Championship / Consolations will take place over two successive weekends. All riders enter the Inter-District and Gauteng Championship / Consolations as individuals in the level in which their horse(s) is registered but at the same time they will represent the District

	<p>in which their club is registered. The top three riders from each District in each level will represent their District and qualify for the Inter-District and the Gauteng Championship / Consolation in that level.</p> <p>These riders will be eligible to receive District Colours. In addition to the 3 District representatives in each level, the next highest qualifiers will also go through to the Inter-District and Gauteng Championship / Consolation to a maximum of 20 riders in each level. This number may increase at the discretion of the Organisers. Should there be an excess of entries, the top 10 places in each level in the Inter-District Championship / Consolation will qualify to ride the Freestyle in each level (except Preliminary where there is no Freestyle) to count towards the Gauteng Championship / Consolation. All other places will ride in the Freestyle Consolation. The cumulative total percentage of the Inter-District Championship / Consolation as well as the Freestyle in each level will determine the Gauteng Champion in each level.</p> <p>The Organizing Committee reserves the right to add wild card entries or to hold additional pools on another day to accommodate riders where circumstances warrant it. These will be additional entries so that all riders who have qualified will not be jeopardized.</p>
Selection of Riders for the Championship / Consolation	<p>In the event of there being:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One pool per level: the top 3 qualifiers from each District will qualify plus the next qualifiers up until 20 riders per level. • Two or more pools using the same judges for each pool: the top 3 qualifiers from each District will qualify plus the next qualifiers up until 20 riders per level. • Two pools using different judges for each pool: the top 3 qualifiers from each District across the pools will qualify plus an equal number from each pool up until 20 riders per level. • In the event of a tie for the 20th place, all of the tying horses will go through. <p>Where there are insufficient entries and at the sole discretion of the Organizers, levels may not be awarded the Gauteng Championship / Consolation in that level.</p>
Championship / Consolation	<p>The Championship / Consolation in each category, except the Preliminary Category, will be calculated by adding the total percentage of the Championship / Consolation class in each category with the total percentage of the Freestyle class in each category.</p> <p>The Preliminary Championship / Consolation will be awarded to the winner of the Preliminary Championship / Consolation class.</p> <p>In the event of a tie in all categories, the higher percentage obtained in the Qualifier and then the Warm-up class will be the deciding factor.</p>
Prizes Money	Prize Money will be at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
Number of Horses	A rider may not qualify more than 2 horses for the Inter-District Championship / Consolation in any one class, unless at the Organizer's discretion, the lack of numbers and the availability of suitable timetabling permits the rider to ride more than 2 horses in one class.
No. of Tests per Day	No horse may compete in more than 2 tests per day up to and including Elementary-Medium level. Horses may only compete in one test per day at DSA Medium level and above.
Registered Grade	A horse may ONLY compete in the grade in which it is registered. This does not apply to Para-Dressage competitions. Pony Rider & Children's classes in the same grade will be combined.
Variation of Programme	The advertised programme and classes will be adhered to as far as possible. However, in the light of unforeseen circumstances the Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide or postpone any class providing such alteration is within the frame work of Rules. No refunds after closing date of entries.
Riding Times	<p>Once riders with more than one horse have been timetabled, a random draw will establish the order of riding.</p> <p>Times will be posted on KPC website and DSA website. The onus is on the competitor to check the final starting order before the start of the class at the arena that the classes are to be held.</p>
Prize Giving Ceremonies	All Prize-Giving Ceremonies will be un-mounted but correctly dressed. The Prize Giving times will be specified on the programme. Failure to be present at the prize-giving ceremony without ceremonies prior arrangement may result in disqualification and the forfeiting of all prize-money.
Bridle Numbers	Will be allocated and this number must be attached to the LEFT-HAND SIDE of the halter/head collar and/or to the numnah/Bridle.
Rules & Regulations	The event will be run under DSA rules unless otherwise stated. FEI tests comply with FEI rules. The Gauteng Championship / Consolation in each category may only be awarded to bona fide Gauteng Riders as stipulated by the Gauteng Sports Confederation.
Callers & Whips	All Warm Up and Qualifying classes may use a whip and a caller except from FEI Prix St Georges levels up. All Championship / Consolation classes, except where Para-Equestrian allows otherwise, will be ridden from memory and without whips.

Passports	All competitors must have their up-to-date horse passports at the event for inspection at any time. Horses whose passports do not fully comply with the current Government, FEI, DSA and General regulations may be refused permission to compete and asked to leave the venue.
African Horse Sickness & Equine Flu	All horses must be vaccinated with AHS vaccine and with Equine Influenza and in accordance with the regulations laid out in the equestrian rules. Horses that do not comply may be refused permission to compete and can be asked to leave the show grounds.
Testing & Checking	Both horses and athletes may be tested at any time during the show for prohibited substances. Saddlery and bits may be checked before and/or after competitors enter/leave the arena.
Substitutions	As per DSA rules. Substitutions may not take place on and after the first day of the show.
Objections & Appeals	As per General Regulations 2018, all Objections and Appeals must be lodged with the Show Director or Show Secretary in writing within the specified time and accompanied by the required deposit.
Schooling of Horses	Under no account, and under penalty of disqualification, may any horse, except those ridden by Para Dressage athletes (where allowed), take part in any class should that horse have been schooled under saddle by anyone other than the competitor concerned from the start of the 1st day of the show until the end of that horse's last class.
Saddlery & Dress	The event will be run under current DSA Rules and General Regulations unless otherwise stated.
Conduct	Any owner or rider who attempts to interfere with or influence judges, officials or stewards, or who at any time on the show grounds uses any contemptuous or abusive language to any of the judges, officials or stewards will forfeit his/her rights to any prizes to which they might otherwise be entitled and will receive a yellow card which will require them to remove themselves and their horse from the grounds pending a disciplinary enquiry.
Indemnity Responsibility	All persons participating at this event do so at their own risk and will have no claim against Kyalami Park Club (KPC), South African Equestrian Federation (SAEF), DSA (Dressage South Africa including any officials, employees, members, affiliated bodies, show-holding bodies or sponsors of KPC, DSA or SAEF, for any damage or loss of property or death or injury of persons suffered during or in connection with this event from any cause whatsoever. No minor may participate in this event without the permission of his/her guardian, who indemnifies KPC, DSA and SAEF (including all other persons and bodies) against any such claims by such minors.
Professional Rider Classification	A Professional is a rider riding Advanced and above or have ridden Advanced and above in the last two years is considered a professional. Also, any person earning money from teaching, training or work riding within the equine industry will be considered a professional.
Professional / Amateur Classes	The Professional classes will be open for entry to amateur riders, if an amateur rider chooses to enter into the professional section, they will NOT be eligible for prizes in the amateur section. No rider may cross enter between sections, all horses ridden by a specific rider shall be either entered into the professional classes or the amateur classes. The Amateur classes are only open for entry to amateur riders.

PLEASE KEEP ALL DOGS ON A HAND-HELD LEASH AT ALL TIMES. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL INCUR A R1000 SPOT FINE

ADULT PROFESSIONAL CLASSES (Professional: rider riding Advanced and above or have ridden Advanced and above in the last two years is considered a professional. Also, any person earning money from teaching, training or work riding within the equine industry will be considered a professional).

Note: Professional classes will be open for entry to amateur riders, if an amateur rider chooses to enter into the professional section, they will NOT be eligible for prizes in the amateur section. No rider may cross enter between sections, all horses ridden by a specific rider shall be either entered into the professional classes or the amateur classes.
