PRIZE MONEY:	60% for all Open classes (subject to General Regulation 01.12.0.5) and 40% for all other classes.
RESTRICTIONS:	There will be no restrictions on the number of entries accepted or the number of horses per rider. Derby classes will be limited to two qualified horses per rider.

DRESS:	Jackets must be worn for all classes
STABLING:	Limited stabling will be available at R200 per horse per night. Initial bedding will be provided.

NOTES:

1. **RULES:** This Event will be run strictly in accordance with the regulations and rules laid down by the South African Equestrian Federation (SAEF), SASJ, SASA & KPC except where amended by this schedule. The rules applicable to each discipline are set out under those discipline's sections and must be read in conjunction with the General Regulations.

2. **ELIGIBILITY:** At the closing date of entry, all owners and riders must be members of, and horses must be registered with, a club and Discipline.

3. ENTRIES:

3.1 Unless entries are accompanied by the correct entry fee (attached to the online entry), they will not be accepted.

3.2 Entry Fees are specified under each section.

3.3 Any enquiries should be addressed to the Show Secretary, Telephone: 010 023 0712.

4. **ORDER OF RIDING:** Competitors must ride strictly in the order given in the official programme or daily starting lists. Competitors may be eliminated from a competition if they are not ready to enter the arena when called upon to do so by the Marshalling Steward.

5. **SUBSTITUTIONS & BUYING OF ENTRIES:** Substitutions must be made in accordance with the relevant rules applicable to each discipline except where otherwise stated in this schedule. Application for substitution must be made on the official substitution form and must be lodged with the Show Secretary within the specified times laid down in the rules. Buying of entries is strictly through the KPC office, and **there will be no further buying & selling of entries 5th May 2019**

6. **PROTESTS:** All protests and appeals must be lodged in writing with the Show Director or Show Secretary within the specified times and must be accompanied by a deposit of R750.00.

7. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS, DAMAGE OR INJURY:** SAEF, KPC, SASJ, SASA, The Sponsors, Competitors, Officials or any other person or body connected with organising or competing in this Event will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained by owners, competitors, officials, members of the public or any other person or their property in connection with the SA Pony Rider, Children & Junior Rider Derby Show.

8. **AMENDMENT AND/OR CANCELLATION OF CLASSES:** The Organising Committee in consultation with the relevant discipline representative, reserves the right, if insufficient or excessive entries are received or in the light of unforeseen circumstances, to combine, handicap, divide, postpone or cancel any classes. Should this be necessary, the prize money will be adjusted accordingly.

9. **OBLIGATIONS:** It is a condition of entry to this event that:

9.1. All competitors entered are obliged to compete in all competitions for which they have qualified.

9.2. All riders asked to appear in parades, displays or prize-giving ceremonies are obliged to do so.

9.3. No blanket may be worn by any horse in the Derby Arena unless permission is given by the Show Director. This permission will only be given in the case of inclement weather.

Failure to comply with any of the above may result in the forfeiture of all prize money, trophies and grading points won at the Event.

10. **PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONIES:** Only the top 5 places in every class will receive rosettes and prizes in the arena, all other prize winners to collect their rosettes and prizes from the marshal. This shall be at the discretion of the organizing committee.

11. **PASSPORTS:** All horses entered must have a valid FEI or SAEF Passport, which must be correctly filled in and stamped. Failure to do so will result in a fine.

AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS: (Government Notice No R254/6/2/97) all passports must have the African Horse Sickness vaccine endorsed in the passport that the horse has been vaccinated by a Registered Veterinarian as prescribed by the manufacturer within the past 12 months. Failure to comply will result in a fine.

EQUINE INFLUENZA

All horses must be vaccinated against Equine Influenza in accordance with SAEF Regulations. Failure to comply will result in a fine.

CRUELTY AND PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES: SAEF rules regarding cruelty and the use of prohibited substances will be strictly observed. At the discretion of SAEF, any horse or rider may be tested for the presence of prohibited substances.

12. **TIMETABLE:** Whilst the published timetable will be adhered to as far as possible, the Organising Committee in consultation with the Discipline Representative reserves the right to make such alterations as it deems necessary. All alterations will be posted on the KPC website as well. Competitors are advised to check the starting times of their classes with the Show Secretary, or on the website: www.kyalamiparkclub.co.za as well as the disciplines' websites

14. REFUNDS:

No Refunds will be given after closing date of entries. Any entries cancelled before the closing date will be refunded 80% of the entry fee.

15. **DOGS:** All dogs must be on a hand-held leash, failure to comply will incur an immediate R1000 fine.

RULES:

1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except the working riding and working hunter where the maximum number of horses/ponies per rider is 3.
2. All Competitors (Riders, Owners & horses) in Open & Novice classes have to be registered with SASA or must pay a Temporary membership of R80 with their entry fees. Temporary members will not earn Rider Ranking or Victor Ludorum Points. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za.
3. All competitors must be registered with a Club and be a member of SAEF. SAEF day Membership Fee R150. Once a rider has done more than two shows, then the rider must register online and become a full SAEF member.
4. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. That includes In Hand and Under Saddle classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za. EDTS members will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
5. Registered SASA coaches will earn National Coaches Victor Ludorum points.
6. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-10 fences, one of which will be a combination. Pony Rider's Max. 0.90m, Juniors Max. 1.00m

Entry Fee: R500 per class. (Incl. R64.98 KPC levy, R23.65 Security/ Medical Levy (Inc 15% VAT), R37.50 SASA levy, R4.50 EDTS Levy, R50.00 Officials Levy (Excl. Vat 15%))

Non KPC Members will pay an extra R400.00 Temp membership fee per rider.

Plus, R20 Refundable Number Deposit to be paid per horse

ELIGIBILITY : Open to all Competitors (Riders, Owners & horses) in the Compleat classes have to be registered with SASA or must pay a Temporary membership of R80 with their entry fees. Temporary members will not earn Rider Ranking or Victor Ludorum Points. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za. All competitors must be a member of a Club and SAEF. . SAEF day Membership Fee R150. Once a rider has done more than two shows, then the rider must register online and become a full SAEF member.

SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. That includes In Hand and Under Saddle classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za. EDTS members will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.

Registered SASA coaches will earn National Coaches Victor Ludorum points.

RULES:

1. A horse eliminated from one test may not be placed higher than competitors completing all 5 tests.
2. To equalise the influence of the dressage phase (Test 4), a multiplying factor will be applied to the dressage score.
3. Tack as per showing or working classes may be used.
4. Any competitor who qualifies for the free test may only scratch from this phase on presentation of a medical or veterinary certificate.

TESTS:

1. Conformation, Movement (walk and trot) and Turnout.
2. Ride by Judge (Juniors Only)
3. Obedience and versatility (a working riding horse type of test)
4. Dressage (specially written test). Restricted to top 15 qualified Horses/ Ponies from Tests 1, 2, 3.

THIS PHASE IS RESTRICTED TO THE BEST QUALIFIED PONIES IN TESTS 1 AND 3 FOR PONY RIDERS AND HORSES IN TESTS 1, 2, & 3 FOR JUNIORS. THE NUMBER OF QUALIFIERS WILL BE ARRIVED AT BY TAKING 30% OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF HORSES ENTERED, ADJUSTED TO THE NEAREST WHOLE NUMBER, OR 15 HORSES, WHICHEVER IS GREATER.

5. Jumping (Restricted to qualifiers from Test 4):

A course of Approximately 8 – 10 fences of Approx 0.80m for Pony Riders & 0.90m for Juniors & Adults.

- a. 2 Faults for each knock or refusal will be deducted from 15 with a worst possible score of 0. 3 refusals will result in elimination from this phase.
- b. Points out of 15 for the style of jumping in respect of the horse only.

6. Free Test:

Open to the best five horses/ponies overall in Tests 1 to 5. Each of the five will be given two minutes to show off the best aspects of his horse/pony in the Derby Arena. This may include one or more jumps if the rider so desires. No fire may be used; safety of the horse/pony and rider in the free test is paramount. Rider of horse/pony must be in control of the horse/pony at all times. Failure to comply with the above will entail elimination.

CLASSIFICATION: The winner of the Compleat Horse/Pony Derby is the horse/pony with the highest aggregate score in the five tests for Pony Riders and the six tests for Juniors. In the event of a tie the best score in Test 6 will be the deciding factor. Should there still be a tie then the best score in Tests 2 and 3 Combined – Will be the deciding Factor for the Juniors and Tests 1 and 3 for Pony Riders.
