Prizes Money & Prize Giving Obligations	<u>LOWER GRADE (GRADED) & HIGHER GRADE AMATEUR SERIES:</u> Rosettes only, Prize Money (accumulated over the series) for the Final Leg (Less levies & VAT). <u>PROFESSIONAL CLASSES:</u> a minimum of 40% of entry fees (less levies & VAT) distributed overall at the discretion of the Organising Committee, subject to DSA general Regulations.
Variation of Programme	The advertised programme and classes will be adhered to as far as possible. However, in the light of unforeseen circumstances the Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide or postpone any class providing such alteration is within the frame work of Rules. No refunds after closing date of entries. An athlete may compete in any level on any horse Hors Concours. Adult "Open" Riders can compete on horses at a level higher than the horses present grade – in accordance with DSA Rules.
Riding Times	Times will be posted on KPC website and DSA website. The onus is on the competitor to check the final starting order before the start of the class at the arena that the classes are to be held.
Bridle Numbers	Will be allocated and this number must be attached to the LEFT-HAND SIDE of the halter/head collar and/or to the numnah/Bridle.
Passport	All competitors must have their up-to-date horse passports at the event for inspection at any time. Horses whose passports do not fully comply with the current Government, FEI, DSA and General regulations may be refused permission to compete and asked to leave the venue.
Saddlery & Dress	The event will be run under current DSA Rules and General Regulations unless otherwise stated.
African Horse Sickness & Equine Flu	All horses must be vaccinated with AHS vaccine and with Equine Influenza and in accordance with the regulations laid out in the equestrian rules. Horses that do not comply may be refused permission to compete and can be asked to leave the show grounds.
Conduct	Any owner or rider who attempts to interfere with or influence judges, officials or stewards, or who at any time on the show grounds uses any contemptuous or abusive language to any of the judges, officials or stewards will forfeit his/her rights to any prizes to which they might otherwise be entitled and will receive a yellow card which will require them to remove themselves and their horse from the grounds pending a disciplinary enquiry.
Indemnity Responsibility	All persons participating at this event do so at their own risk and will have no claim against Kyalami Park Club (KPC), South African Equestrian Federation (SAEF), DSA (Dressage South Africa including any officials, employees, members, affiliated bodies, show-holding bodies or sponsors of KPC, DSA or SAEF, for any damage or loss of property or death or injury of persons suffered during or in connection with this event from any cause whatsoever. No minor may participate in this event without the permission of his/her guardian, who indemnifies KPC, DSA and SAEF (including all other persons and bodies) against any such claims by such minors

LOWER GRADE AMATEUR SERIES

This series is aimed at the riders that would like to try their hand at competitive Dressage. It is for the beginner and recreational riders. Riders will have the opportunity to compete at a pristine venue whilst having fun! Riders and horses need to be dressed and turned out correctly. Rosettes will be handed out at all the legs and Prize Money, Rosettes and Title will be for the Winner at the Final Leg. To qualify for the Title, you need to have competed in at least 3 of the legs including the final. The highest 6 (Prelim to Novice) marks will be averaged to determine the Title winner in each grade.

HIGHER GRADE AMATEUR SERIES

This series is aimed at riders that have competed in Dressage up to Medium level. Riders will receive rosettes for all the Legs, except for the Final Leg – where the accumulated monies (from the previous legs) will be awarded to the Final winners (less all the levies). To qualify for the Title, you need to have competed in at least 3 of the legs including the final. The highest 6 (Prelim to EM) / 3 (Medium to Advanced) marks will be averaged to determine the Title winner in each grade.

Riders that would like to compete in the Medium & Advanced classes of this series must apply to dressage@kyalamiparkclub.co.za to be approved as an amateur rider.
