Kyalami Park Club Development Rider Programme

DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Kyalami Park Club's development Rider programme is open to all riders of all ages and disciplines. Currently KPC will be making 10 spaces available for Development Riders.

Development riders will be awarded free KPC membership for the year, as well as free entries to KPC shows on their nominated Development horse.

Definition:

A development rider is any rider that has a talent and passion for horse-riding in one of the disciplines offered by the Club but does not have the financial means or backing to pursue their ambitions.

Applications need to be completed and submitted to manager@kyalamiparkclub.co.za before the 1st of December of each year.

All applications need to be accompanied by the following documents.

1. Completed application form
2. Motivational letter from the proposer
3. Past 12 months show results (will be verified with the discipline by the selectors)
4. Copy of applicants Identity Document

*Please note that the proposer needs to be a paid-up member of KPC in good standing.

SELECTION PROCESS

All completed applications submitted together with the correct paperwork will be considered. The selectors will be the KPC Executive Committee.

The EXCO will convene during December of each year to select the development riders for the following year. Successful applicants will be notified via email by the 31st of December.

OBLIGATIONS TO THE CLUB

- Riders may compete on one (1) horse for free during the year. This horse needs to be specified at the time of the time of the rider's successful application.
- Riders will be bound by the Club Constitution
- Riders will be required to compete in a minimum of five (5) KPC shows during the year.
- Riders will be required to use a KPC Numnah at these shows, which need to be handed back at the end of every show.
- Riders are expected to be ambassadors for KPC at every show they attend.
- Riders need to provide the Club with an interim progress report in June.
