

I have over 42 years of combined softball experience. I have been a player and, captain, and a leader of various softball institutions. I played for Ipopeng high school, Phiri kolobe High School, and University of Limpopo. I also played for Mahwelereng Spikes Softball club. I was the treasurer and Chairman of the club. I became the treasurer of Limpopo Softball Association from 2002 to 2007 and was elected the president of Limpopo Softball Association in 2007. I served the association as the president until 2015.

I was elected the treasurer of Limpopo Sport confederation in 2012. I was again re-elected to this position in 2016. I managed to ensure that the sport confederation prepares managements accounts and audited financial statements. Limpopo sport confederation has managed to annually present audited annual financial statements to its stakeholders to date without fail. I am currently serving my last term as the treasurer of the sports confederation.

I have achieved the following accolades as a sport administrator: 1.Limpopo Sport administrator of the year 2018, 2. Final nominee, national sport administrator of the year at the national sport awards held in Free State in Bloemfontein in 2018.

I was elected the treasurer of Softball South Africa (SSA) in 2006. I served SSA in this position until 2010. I was elected the acting president of SSA in 2011 after the federation was put under administration by SASCOC due to noncompliance. The softball stakeholders gave me the mandate to rescue the organisation from non-governance to a complying federation. I managed to achieve this mandate in 2015. SASCOC lifted the administration tag from the federation in 2015. Softball is now played in all the nine provinces and has properly elected provincial executive committees. The federation went for an elective Annual General Meeting (AGM0 in August 2015. I was elected the president of SSA to serve softball for a period of four years at this AGM. I was again re-elected to serve softball in this position at the last elective AGM in August 2019. I am now serving my last term as the president of the federation. SSA received the federation of the year award in 2019 at the national sports awards held in Bloemfontein under my leadership. The federation also managed to launch the national league for the first time in the history of softball in 2019. SSA was selected by the department of Sport and Recreation of South Africa (SRSA)as one of the priority codes in 2015. The federation is still one of the priority codes to date. The executive committee of SSA has managed to work together with its associate members seamlessly. All the associate members are represented on the executive committee of the federation. All the associate members hold their national championships under the supervision of the federation. SSA is a member of SASCOC in good standing. SSA has managed to prepare and submit all the required compliance documents to SASCOC and SRSA annually without fail.

Internationally SSA is a member of the following bodies: Region 5 Softball governing body, African Baseball Softball Association and World Baseball Softball Confederation. I was elected the president of softball in Africa at the African Baseball Softball Association by all the African Softball playing countries in Botswana in 2017. I currently serve on the executive board of World Baseball Softball Confederation Softball Division. I assumed this role in 2017 and I represent the African continent in this board. I have managed to organise three African qualifiers for the world cups and one Olympic qualifier to date. Softball has grown in the Continent under my leadership. SSA has improved its rankings internationally under my leadership. SSA is now ranked number 10 in the men division and number 26 in the women division internationally. We are currently ranked number one in both men and women divisions in our continent (Africa).

I am currently self-employed running my own business consultancy firm called Versatex Trading 505(Pty) Ltd. Prior to this I worked for the following companies: 1. Mashilo

Matsetela Consulting as a business manager 2. Woolworths (Pty) Ltd as a store manager 3. MOKOPANE College as a lecturer.

I currently serve as a Non-Executive Director of the following significant boards of companies: 1. Sadtu Investment Holding (Pty) Ltd, 2. Ubuntu Botho Investment Holding (Pty) Ltd 3.
