CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in International Equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses' welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health, before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the Event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper Veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

Bought and Sold Entries will be allowed as long as the correct documentation is submitted within the correct time frames and the original rider has signed the form. There will be no buying and selling of entries after 23 September 2021. Forms received thereafter will not be accepted.

REFUNDS: No Refunds will be given after closing date of entries. Entries withdrawn before close of date will be refunded. However due to inclement weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, should it necessitate cancelling the show, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Bank Details: **All entries to be paid for by closing of date entries otherwise a late payment fee will be incurred.**

AHS and EQUINE FLU REGULATIONS

1 African Horse Sickness (AHS)

African Horse Sickness is a controlled disease in South Africa; therefore, any suspicion of a clinical case of AHS anywhere in the country must be reported to the local State Veterinarian immediately.

Symptoms of AHS include high temperature, rapid breathing, coughing followed by a frothy fluid from the nostrils and death within a few hours. In less acute cases, swelling of the neck and head particularly above the eyes and redness of the mucous membranes.

1 African Horse Sickness Zones

The Republic of South Africa has been divided into four zones, namely:

- 1 AHS Free Zone
- 2 AHS Surveillance Zone
- 3 AHS Protection Zone
- 4 AHS Infected Zone.

All Equines in South Africa except in the AHS Free and Surveillance Zones are required to be vaccinated against AHS annually, with an effective remedy registered in section 1, of Act 101 of 1965.

Equines residing in the AHS Free and AHS Surveillance Zones require permission from the State Directorate for vaccination against AHS.

All equines residing in the AHS Protection and Infected Zones must be vaccinated annually against AHS.

In the AHS Free, Surveillance and Protection Zone vaccination is only allowed between 1st June and 31st October of each year.

Whilst it is not a requirement that horses in the AHS Infected Zone be vaccinated between 1st June and 31st October it has been strongly recommended.

Therefore, the SAEF AHS Vaccination Requirements are as follows:

- 1 All Equines competing in SAEF events are required to have an annual AHS vaccine with a vaccine registered under Act 101 of 1965. The vaccine consists of AHS 1 and AHS 2. The vaccine has to be administered by a registered Veterinarian, registered with the South African Veterinary Council with a minimum period of 21 days between the two vaccines.
- 2 The Vaccine and batch number must be written in the appropriate vaccination page and signed and stamped by the Veterinarian administering the vaccine.
- 3 Horses residing in the AHS Free, Surveillance and Protection Zones may only be vaccinated between 1st June and 31st of October each year.
- 4 Horses that reside in the AHS Free and Surveillance Zones and participate in events in these Zones only are exempt from the necessity of annual AHS vaccination. However, if they wish to compete in the AHS Protection or AHS Infected Zones, they must be vaccinated.
- 5 AHS vaccinations that are given with an interval of less than the minimum 21 days are null and void for both vaccinations and horses that have received such vaccinations will be deemed not to have been vaccinated.

No horse may compete for 7 days following any vaccination.

Equine Influenza (EI)

1. All Horses participating in SAEF Events must be vaccinated against Equine Influenza
2. An initial Primary Course of two vaccinations must be given; the second vaccination must be administered within 21-92 days of the first vaccination. In completing the primary course of the vaccinations, the vaccine must be the same manufacturer for example you initially vaccinate with Proteq the second must be the same.
3. The First Booster must be given within 7 calendar months following the date of administration of the second vaccination of the primary Course. All horses that were certified as correctly receiving the Primary Course prior to 1 January 2005 (under previous regulations), are not required to fulfill the requirement for the First Booster, providing there has been no lapse in their vaccination regime.
4. Booster Vaccinations
 - a) The minimum booster frequency is every 12 months.
 - b) However, for Horses competing, the last Booster must have been given within 6 months +21 days (and not within 7 days) before arrival at the Event.

Horses **must** have been vaccinated within 6 months +21 days of arriving at the Event however they **cannot** compete if they have been vaccinated within 7 days of arriving at an event venue.

MEDICATION CONTROL:

MCP testing as per SAEF Regulations will be done by the appointed Testing Vet.

Laboratory: National Horse Racing Authority, Turffontein Race Course, Turf Club Street.

PROTESTS & APPEALS:

As per General Regulations. All protests and Objections must be done in writing within the required timelines and in receipt of a R600 deposit.

COVID – 19 RESTRICTIONS

This show will be run under COVID-19 restrictions in place at the time.

1. All riders, officials, staff, support staff and medics agree and confirm to comply with the SA Government and SAEF Covid-19 guidelines and protocols as set out on the SAEF website www.saeef.org.za when entering a show/event.
2. A rider may only be accompanied by their groom and one driver (if needed). In the case of underage riders, they may be accompanied by one parent or guardian. No spectators are allowed.
3. All attendees will be obliged to report to the COVID 19 Officer/employee, upon entry of the premises to sign the register, sanitise their hands, and have their temperature taken and recorded. The name of the Compliance Officer will be indicated on the schedule.
4. It is compulsory for all attendees to wear masks on the property at all times and adhere to social distancing protocols.
5. There will be no prize giving ceremony allowed, award certificates will be sent by email, prize money by EFT- at the discretion of the show holder. Results will be posted online or provided by email.
6. Although the Showholding Body has taken all necessary precautions to ensure compliance to Covid-19 protocols and guidelines as stipulated by the Department of Health, it is important to note that neither the Showholding Body, DSA or SAEF can be held responsible for any person contracting COVID-19 at the said venue. All attendees are entering the venue at their own risk.
7. Should any attendee at the show contravene any of the Covid-19 regulations, then he/she will be asked by the Covid-19 Compliance Officer to leave the venue immediately. There will be no refunds for show entries.
8. It is not compulsory for riders to wear masks while mounted. Riders must return to his/her parking spot upon completion of his/her round to un-tack, load and leave as soon as possible.

RULES:

- The Mini Derby** Restricted to the three top qualified Horse/Pony and Rider combinations based on points gained in Classes H1 & H2, H7 & H8 and H13 & H 14. NB: Ponies measuring 1.48 and under are not eligible to compete in the Junior Mini Dressage Derby. (Please note the 4th placed horse must be available to ride as the ‘dummy’ ride on Derby Day).
- The Dressage Derby** restricted to the three top qualified Horse/Pony & Rider combinations based on points gained in classes H4 & H5, H10 & H11 and H16 & H17. NB: Ponies measuring 1.48 and under are not eligible to compete in the Junior Dressage Derby. (Please note the 4th placed horse must be available to ride as the ‘dummy’ ride on Derby Day).

Ties will be awarded full points

- In the event of equality of points for any three qualifying places the marks gained in Class H2, H5, H8, H11, H14 & H17 by tying competitors will be the deciding factor. Should the tie persist, the collective shall be the deciding factor. If the tie persists, the judges will make the final decision.
- 1 The Competitor qualifying in 4th place must be available in case one of the three qualifiers is unable to compete and will be required to ride a *test ride* for the judges at the beginning of the competition.
- Each Rider rides his own horse first and thereafter will ride in the following order starting with the lowest qualification combination.
Rider 1-2-3-2-3-1-3-1-2
Horse 1-2-3-1-2-3-1-2-3
- Each Rider is given three minutes to ride the strange horse before starting the test.

7. In the event of equality of marks for the winning rider the total of the Individual marks given by each Judge in all three tests for the Rider's "position & seat & correct use of aids" shall be the deciding factor. The same procedure shall apply should there be a tie for the winning horse, except that the marks given for "paces" will be the deciding factor.
8. Riders may only ride one horse/pony in Class H3, H6, H9, H12, H15 & H18. Should a Rider qualify more than one horse, the Rider shall have the option to nominate the horse he chooses to ride when paying the Starters Fee.
9. A Horse/Pony and Rider combination may not enter the Dressage Derby qualifiers if they do not intend to compete in the Derby if they qualify.
