GENERAL CONDITIONS

This event is organised under:

- SASA Showing Rules and Annexures
- SAEF General Regulations
- SASA Rules Edition 25 effective 1st January 2025

The event will be run under SASA and SAEF rules unless otherwise stated.

1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.
2. All Riders and Horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF and SASA. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za. Temporary SASA Membership of R115
3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. That includes In Hand and Under Saddle classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za EDTS competitors will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.
5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.
6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 25 effective 1st January 2025
7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.
8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.
9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge
10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.
11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.
12. All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za
13. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.
14. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the province where the rider is resident.
15. On no account, and under penalty of disqualification, may any horse take part in any of the showing classes if the horse has been ridden by anyone other than the competitor or judge from the first day of the show until the end of the last class in which that horse competes.
16. A deposit of R20 for a number is included in the entry fee.

REFUNDS:

No Refunds will be given after closing date of entries. Entries withdrawn before close of date will be refunded less payfast fees. However, due to inclement weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, should it necessitate cancelling the show, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Class F19 **The Toyota SA Grooms Handler Class**

Open to all grooms showing horses/ponies. **The class will be judged on handling ability.**

Conformation will **not** be considered.

Class F20 **The Toyota SA Grooms Performance Riding Class**

Open to all grooms riding horses/ponies. Each competitor will be given three minutes to set up and two minutes to show off the best aspects of his horse/pony in the Arena. This may include one or more jumps if the rider so desires. No fire may be used; safety of the horse and rider in this test is paramount. The rider of the horse must always be in control of the horse.

Class: G1 **THE 2025 TOYOTA SA ADULT COMPLEAT HORSE DERBY**

AWARDS: The Mamselle Romance Trophy
THE SA COMPLEAT HORSE MEDALLION AND SASH, SASA Gold Medal

PRIZE MONEY: A minimum of 60% of entry fees, less levies & VAT, plus sponsorship spread over all classes.

RULES:

1. A horse eliminated from one test may not be placed higher than competitors completing all 5 tests. Competitors eliminated in any one test will score "0" for that test but are not eliminated from the competition.
2. To equalise the influence of the dressage phase (Test 4), a multiplying factor will be applied to the dressage score.
3. If there are not sufficient entries in this section, the class will be cancelled
4. Tack as per showing or working horse classes may be used
5. Any competitor who qualifies for the free test may only scratch on presentation of a medical or veterinary certificate.
6. All classes will be run under Edition 25, Effective 1st January 2025
7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.

TESTS:

1. Confirmation, Movement (walk and trot), and Turnout.
2. Obedience and Versatility (a working riding horse type of test).
3. Ride by the Judge
4. Dressage (DSA Elementary Test 1).

THIS PHASE IS RESTRICTED TO THE BEST QUALIFIED HORSES IN TESTS 1, 2, AND 3. THE NUMBER OF QUALIFIERS WILL BE ARRIVED AT BY TAKING 30% OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF HORSES ENTERED, ADJUSTED TO THE NEAREST WHOLE NUMBER, OR 15 HORSES, WHICHEVER IS GREATER.

5. Jumping (Restricted to qualifiers from Test 4): A course of approximately 8 – 10 fences of approximately 1.00m for adults.
 - a. 2 Faults for each knock or refusal will be deducted from 15, with a worst possible score of 0. 3 refusals will result in elimination from this phase.
 - b. Points out of 15 for the style of jumping in respect of the horse only.

6. Free Test:

- Open to the best five horses overall in Tests 1 to 5. Each of the five will be given three minutes to set up and two minutes to show off the best aspects of their horse/pony in the Derby Arena. This may include one or more jumps if the rider so desires. Competitors may use the fixed fences excluding the Derby Bank & the water jump, provided prior arrangement has been made with Course Builder.
- No fire may be used; safety of the horse and rider in the free test is paramount.
- The rider of the horse must be in control of the horse/pony always. Failure to comply with the above will entail elimination.

CLASSIFICATION: The winner of the class, who must compete in all tests, will be the horse with the highest overall score, totalled from the 6 tests. In the event of a tie, the best score in Test 6 will be the deciding factor. Should there still be a tie, then the best score in Tests 1 and 2 will be the deciding score.
